DIRECTIONS—PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

BART/MUNI: Exit at the Powell Street station. Walk east one block on Market St. to 4th St. Turn right and walk two blocks to Howard St.

CAL TRAIN: Walk north on 4th St. five blocks to Howard.

DRIVING

FROM BAY BRIDGE: take the 5th St. exit. From 5th turn right onto Folsom St., then left on 3rd. St., and park in the garage on 3rd between Folsom and Howard. Walk to Howard, turn left and walk one block West. If that garage is full, continue on 3rd and turn left on Mission, then left on 5th, then immediately left again on Minna to enter the 5th & Mission Garage. Walk one block south to Howard and one block east to 4th St.

FROM RT. 101 N: follow 80 East. Then take the 4th Street exit. Take a left on Bryant and a left again on Third. (see directions above for parking.)
